

How it ALL BEGAN

A grarian unrest has been a hallmark of Central Luzon's history for over 60 years now. It is the cradle of the Hukbalahap movement which metamorphosed into the Communist Party of the Philippines and the New People's Army.

Thus, the manifestation of idle yet fertile land has been the basis of socio-economic conflict as seen in peasant unrest and the unequal distribution of wealth experienced by our nation.

This is the social backdrop of our fledging Foundation's mission. Nestled in the foothills of the majestic Sierra Madre mountain range in historic San Miguel, Bulacan are over 100 hectares of bucolic hills. These were donated to GreenEarth Heritage Foundation by a generous land-owner in early 2009.

The Land was purchased roughly 40 years ago with the landowner's dream of developing a viable agricultural endeavour. However, as is often said, "work got in the way," and the land was left idle, susceptible to both fraudulent transactions and illegal squatting. Its lush potential was never achieved.

Hence, the decision to cede the raw Garden of Eden to our foundation to ensure its viable promise for beneficiaries without the taint of potential profiteering and the past mistake of non-

Over 139 families live in the foundation's immediate vicinity, mostly in abject poverty. An overwhelming majority of the residents have only attained an elementary level of education and 48 percent of the population are below 20 years old.

GreenEarth's mission is to assist in poverty alleviation by providing livelihoods centered in organic agriculture and by empowering communities through spiritual transformation in the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We believe that it is through a personal relationship with Christ alone that we will be able to bring hope, change and a bright future to the people of the community that we serve.

Dear Friends and Kind Supporters of GreenEarth:

We trust you are all keeping well. We wish to share with you the highlights of our Foundation's programs and initiatives in the past 12 months.

We continued implementing One Meralco Foundation's One for Trees grant award which incepted in 2021 as the grant requires GreenEarth to plant 168,021 indigenous hardwoods and fruit bearing trees. Owing to this major program, GreenEarth was able to employ more than 120 beneficiaries consisting of men, women and some indigenous peoples of the Sierra Madre mountain range.

Sadly, the back-to-back typhoons in the last quarter of 2022 pummeled GreenEarth severely, with more than 2600 mature trees toppling over. Tens of thousands of seedlings planted on-field died. Thousands more seedings thriving in the nursery were wiped out overnight. Our spirits were crushed by the heartbreaking events of late, but we refuse to be defeated. We continue the arduous work of restoration and continue to seek partnerships to help us rebuild.

GreenEarth was judged the sole winner in the Philippines of Fujitsu Japan's Strategic Community Investment Fund. 19 winners were selected globally and GreenEarth is the only Philippine awardee. Fujitsu released their award in January 2023. Fujitsu's assistance post-typhoon is timely and truly an answered prayer for us.

More than 150 donors contributed to GreenEarth's first schoolhouse project through the kind and generous efforts of Ana Infante and Jacob Yao, both Grade 12 students of the International School, Manila. We look forward to a new season in our educational initiatives as we seek partnerships to take GreenEarth to the next level.

GreenEarth likewise received a favorable grant from the British company, Spirax Sarco which manufactures steam management systems and persistaltic pumps and associated fluid path technologies headquartered in Cheltenham, England. It is listed in the London Stock Exchange and is a constituent of the FTSE 100 index. Spirax Sarco Philippines and their Group Education Fund, selected GreenEarth as their partner in the Philippines this year, who will help them deliver their purpose which is to promote inclusive and equitable access to education in the communities wherein the operate. Wit this grant, Spirax Sarco can fulfill 2 of their four aims under its Group Education Fund which are as follows:

To tackle poverty through education. To remove barriers to education.

We are both grateful and blessed by the foregoing new benefactors and their respective distinctive grants.

We look forward to continuous progress and development at GreenEarth owing to these welcome developments. The LORD has made His promise felt that He "will never leave us or forsake us". -- Deuteronomy 31:8

To God be the Glory for His endless generosity and patronage!



Philip Camara is the Founder and CEO of the Philippine Biochar Association as well as the Co-Founder and Chief Agriculturist of the Sambali Beach Farm which serves as a demonstration farm for a sustainable biochar-based vegetable and small livestock farming system for small farmers which achieves remarkable productivity using only natural inputs that are largely produced in the farm. He has a B.S. in Agri-business from the University of the Philippines and a M.S. in Agro-Industrial Systems from Hult International Business School in Cambridge, MA. Persistence and perseverance in letting our needs made known to the Department of Agriculture has brought the DA-RFO 3 engineers back to the farm this year. We are urgently appealing for a design for a much-needed overflow bridge over our frontage creek which serves as a critical segment of our farm-to-market roads.

We also brought up our need to complete the small farm reservoir infrastructure to make the latter more useful during the dry months. Two farm reservoirs were built 10 years ago at GreenEarth by the DA's Bureau of Soil and Water Management. It would be nice if it could be improved using liner technologies at the very least.






FIGURE 2. PROGRAM EXPENSES





FIGURE 3. EXPENSES
